

Introduction & Membership Benefits

Team Defence Information (TD-Info) members are part of a unique not for profit Trade Association, where the UK Defence Industry and the Ministry of Defence (MOD) jointly work on continuous improvement activities, engaging for optimal outcomes across the Defence sector.

Along with MOD Departments, TD-Info has over 160 industry members. Members range from large Defence manufacturers, Small to Medium Enterprises (SMEs) and various academic organisations.

TD-Info is sponsored by the Defence Industrial Joint Council (DIJC) and the MOD three-star posts of; Chief of Defence Logistics and Support (CDLS), Defence Digital Chief Information Officer and Defence Equipment & Support (DE&S) Director General Strategic Enablers and Deputy CEO all of which are within the National Armaments Director's organisation.

TD-Info was established in the 1994 (formally known as the UK Council for electronic Business (UKCeB)) after several prime Defence contractors decided to create a neutral, not-for-profit, forum with the MOD, to cooperate and exchange information for Defence Support. This was underpinned by a strategy to enhance standards, improve Support engineering, and reduce life-cycle costs via a strong partnerships and seamless interaction.

Our Work

TD-Info provides a trusted environment for MOD and the UK Industry to collaboratively work together and share the output from activities. TD-Info member companies and the MOD gain mutual benefit from these research and innovation activities which leads to a force multiplier effect and knowledge sharing.

TD-Info maintains a trusted Defence community, enabling Members to be well-informed and ready to support MOD in developing resilient and cost-effective solutions that support strategic objectives. This is achieved by actively leading a programme of Research and Innovation projects through various specialist Communities of Practice and Working Groups (WGs).

Members and MOD also work together to review and improve relevant policies and procedures. This is re-enforced by TD-Info's active involvement and chairing of standards such as Defence Standard 00-600 and being an influential voice at Aerospace and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD).

Governance

The DIJC is the major conduit for driving effective MOD/Industry relationships and provides strategic direction for TD-Info project activities.

The TD-Info Governance structure includes a 3-star Advisory Board that sets the strategic themes for our collaborative work; a 2-star Strategy Group which “owns” the strategic plan whilst the 1-star Executive Team is the hub of the operation. This acts as a portfolio management board to ensure the programme of activities achieves the desired value and outcomes.

TD-Info holds regular meetings between its members and key stakeholders from MOD Strategic Command, including Defence Support and Defence Digital, and DE&S through various WGs and forums such as the Industry Customer Engagement Forum (ICEF), Information Security Forum, and Trading Forum.
